- Sorting light & dark fabrics colour coordination
- Sewing accurate ¼ inch seams
- Perfectly matched seams
- Cutting fabric on the bias
- Pressing seams
- Squaring off blocks
- Sandwiching a quilt pinning the quilt
- Sewing on a binding without a wavy edge
