Create, play and enjoy the workshop while you learn how to do perfect satin stitch machine appliqué, attach cords, do some bobbin work and how to put the emphasis on your work. This is a class where you will receive a lot of tips to master machine appliqué. It is easy and the result is spectacular!

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- 19 x (2½" x 23") strips - Black with white print fabric OR your own colour choice
- 19 x (2½" x 23") strips – White with black print fabric OR your own colour choice
- 30 cm dark pink/red fabric for the flowers OR 9 x 8" squares of different coloured fabrics
- 25 cm dark green fabric
- 25 cm light green fabric
- 3" Black fabric cut across the width
- Green embroidery thread (DMC 8 or something similar)
- Black embroidery thread (DMC 8 or similar)
- Machine embroidery or ordinary machine thread similar to your fabrics
- Fine gold cord or thick gold thread (optional)
- Black permanent marker
- 2m Appliqué paper
- Blue water soluble pen or a fabric pen
- Sewing machine
- Open toe machine foot – Appliqué or embroidery foot
- Ordinary machine foot or ¼" machine foot
- Lead
- 1m stitch & tear
- Needles (Universal 80 & Embroidery 80)
- Extension cord, 15 amp plug or adaptor
- Iron and small ironing board
- Basic sewing equipment e.g. pins, needles, rotary cutter, cutting mat etc.
